

H2K Enterprises buys Denton building for headquarters

A company formed two years ago in New Orleans has purchased a Denton building for its new headquarters.

Real estate firm Henry S. Miller Brokerage said Wednesday that H2K Enterprises LLC has acquired an 88,000 square-foot industrial building at 2600 East University Drive in Denton.

The building was purchased from Weatherol Supply Co. Terms of the transaction were not disclosed.

H2K was originally established to provide project management, construction, international freight, demolition and storm debris clean up services in several southern states.

But the company has recently expanded its operations nationwide, according to Dan Spika, the Miller Brokerage executive vice president who negotiated the building purchase.
